<p>All Grades: Use Money, place value blocks, and board games to help your student understand the value of math.</p> <p>Count coins up and back. Shop with your student. Have them pay and anticipate the change received. Get creative! Have students sell wares at their own “store” with your supervision. Play board games with your student (NO TECHNOLOGY). Some possible games are: Chutes and Ladders, Risk, Monopoly, Sorry, Life, CandyLand, Rummikube, Yahtzee, and chess. Games that require students to use play money or count spaces on boards are acceptable.</p> <p>Count the minutes that you play as math minutes!
