Life is full of puzzles. Solving puzzles that we encounter daily helps us to develop tenacity, a virtuous trait. Does your student love to solve puzzles? If so, the summer math challenge will be a perfect fit! This summer we are challenging students in all math content areas but giving special focus to solving puzzles. By using number puzzles and jigsaw puzzles, students improve their spatial and logical reasoning and develop better number sense.

When your student solves these puzzles, take pictures of them and email those pictures to me at cdube@genevaschooltx.org. Some students who send pictures will be chosen to play in a giant-sized math game at the Summer Math Awards assembly.

Though the math challenge is NOT mandatory, I highly encourage your student to participate. Over the summer, they lose as much as 2.4 months in their grade-level equivalency when they don't practice.

We have no minimum **MONTHLY** requirements this year! Students will need 450 minutes to qualify for bronze, 600 minutes for silver and 750 minutes for gold. (Again, those students who earn 1000 minutes or more will earn Above and Beyond status.) They can earn minutes any time between the last day of school and back to school night. The other activities that count are included in the attached document. All documents and logs are posted in Parent Resources on our website.

Try to have your student do math activities from each category. Please let me know if you have any questions throughout the summer.







