

2021-2022 REVISED COVID-19 PROTOCOLS GENEVA SCHOOL of BOERNE

Based upon revised CDC guidelines from December 27, we have revised our protocols and they are effective as of January 7, 2022, and are subject to change.

We have established a dedicated Geneva Nurses Health Line for student and family issues regarding COVID-19, as well as other medical situations. Please text or call **830.443.1775**. *Please refrain from using the nurses' personal lines going forward for school/medical related calls, texts or transmission of medical records.*



TESTING

Rapid response testing will be provided by the Geneva nurses while supplies last. In some situations, a negative COVID-19 test may be required for return to school.

EXPOSURE

Contract tracing will not be conducted. Students, faculty and staff will not be required to quarantine if exposed to an infected person at school if they themselves do not have symptoms.

NOTIFICATIONS

Parents will be notified by email of a confirmed on-campus COVID-19 diagnosis within their student's classroom in Grammar School, by grade level if in the Logic and Rhetoric schools, and by team in Athletics.

*MASK RECOMMENDATIONS FOR DAYS 6-10

Medical masks will be required for faculty and staff upon return for days 6-10. Medical masks are strongly encouraged for students returning on days 6-10. Masks may be required for students in certain situations including team environments, travel and other opportunities in order to protect other students.
