## 2022 SUMMER READING CHALLENGE

The Geneva School desires to develop good readers. Reading well requires direction, discipline, and diligence. It is important to include leisurely time when children feel inspired to read during the summer. We hope you will take this challenge and saturate your family with books that are true, noble, right, pure, lovely, admirable, excellent and praiseworthy (Philippians 4:8). We have chosen each book on our summer reading lists with the hope that it cultivates a love for reading and the written word.

While there is much excellent literature available, the purpose of our reading lists is to provide a deliberate, ongoing format for exposure to the classics; books that have stood the test of time. We want every student to read as many classic books as possible.

All books on the reading lists may be found in the Geneva School library. These lists are also provided to Barnes & Noble at La Cantera, the Boerne Public Library, and The Boerne Bookshop for your convenience. The Reading Lists and Reading Log will also be posted on our school website.

#### TO EARN A GOLD, SILVER OR BRONZE MEDAL, STUDENTS MUST

- Read any books from the list for the grade they are *exiting, moving into, or higher* only books read from these lists will count toward silver medal level. After reaching silver medal level, students may read **any** book of their choice or a Triple Crown book as identified on their grade-level reading list.
- Each book read may be counted only once.
- Record the title, author, summary (if necessary, parents may write as incoming K and 1st graders dictate) and number of pages for each book on the Reading Log.
- Please make sure you record the number of pages from the physical book, not from an electronic book (you may read e-books, but only physical book pages may be recorded).
- Parents must initial each book recorded on the log.
- Add up the number of pages read at the end of the summer (incoming Kindergartners may also count pages read **to** them).
- Reading Logs MUST be returned to the teacher at either "Meet the Teacher" or the first day of school. This will count as the first reading homework grade of the school year. Summer Reading medals will be awarded based on the reading log counts and given at the Summer Reading Awards Assembly.
- Incoming 4th/5th graders must complete assigned, required reading selections as reflected on the lists.
