A DIFFERENT MEANS

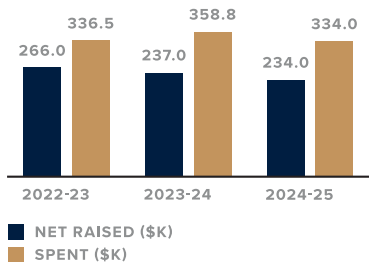

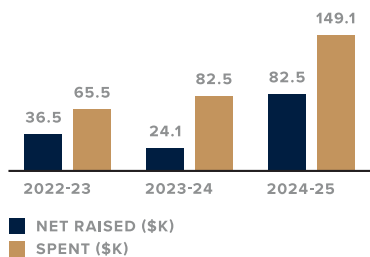

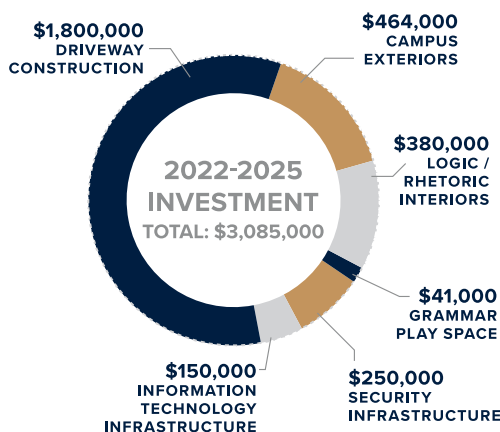

WHAT GENEROSITY HAS DONE

Every year, Geneva's Board of Trustees sets tuition to cover our annual operating expenses. Campus improvements are not included in this annual budget. We rely on our donors for enhancements to our campus. While our annual budget provides for some professional development and tuition assistance, our teachers and our community need more than currently included. Our generous donors have faithfully stepped in to provide for these needs over the last three years:

TUITION ASSISTANCE

- 257 student aid grants

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

- 10 faculty and staff to Harkness training
- 6 faculty to AP training
- 114 faculty to subject area specific training
- 159 faculty and staff to classical, Christian conferences
- 19 days of in-house faculty training
- 7 faculty given formative, educational travel experiences

FACILITIES IMPROVEMENTS

Security:

- Exterior safety lights
- Exterior cameras
- Windows with anti-shatter film
- Controlled access locks
- Store front classroom locks
- Automatic gates

Information Technology (IT):

- Campus-wide WIFI upgrade
- New conduit and wiring
- Internet service redundancy
- Campus-wide loud speakers
